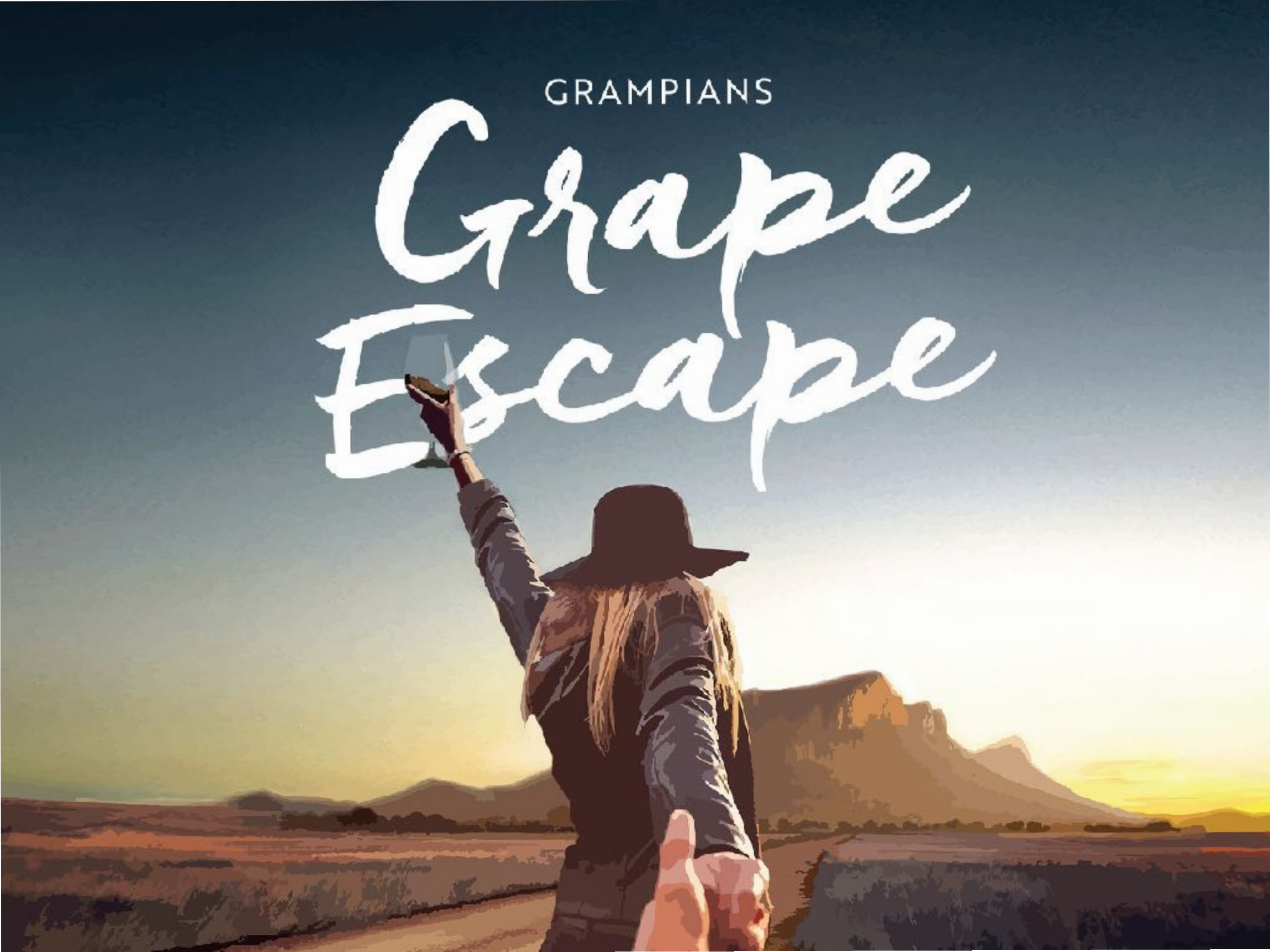

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

AAA rating

Please familiarize yourself with the following information so that you can maintain your good standing with the Festival. Failure to meet our expectations could jeopardise your eligibility to return to the Festival in the future.

Access

Exhibitor access to the Festival Village is via the car park at the Halls Gap Recreation Reserve. Exhibitors will be directed to their site to unload and should then proceed to the general parking area.

- Set Up times:

12pm to 7pm Friday 4 May 2018

7am to 9.00am Saturday 5 May 2018 - (PLEASE NOTE : Pre Paid ticket holders can access from 9:30am with Tasting Tickets commencing at 10am)

7am to 9:30 am Sunday 6 May 2018

All vehicles must be offsite by 9.00am Saturday and 9.30am Sunday. If you arrive late be prepared to carry your stock to your marquee from the car park. Vehicles must travel at walking pace/ 5km per hour speed limit, windows down, hazards on.

ATMs & banking

ATM and EFTPOS facilities will be available within the Festival Village. An ANZ ATM is also located in the main street of Halls Gap. Exhibitors are reminded to take all precautions for receiving and storing cash. The festival does not have the facilities to offer cash exchange.

Canvassing

The distribution of promotional materials and the canvassing of business opportunities are restricted to the exhibitor's own site.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Code of conduct

Exhibitors must demonstrate a positive approach towards the public, each other and the Festival.

Clean skins

The sale of clean skin bottles or unlabelled boxed wine is not permitted.

GGE Coolroom

You must purchase space when you register to access the Festival cool rooms. All produce should be in a sturdy container and clearly labeled with your name and contact details. Please deliver goods straight to the cool rooms and note that they will be locked overnight.

Dismantling

Exhibitors may not dismantle their stands until all patrons have left the Festival village on Sunday afternoon.

Decorate your marquee

Please give thought to how you would like to dress your marquee. This includes thinking about how to attach things to the side of the marquee. Please do not attach tape directly to the marquee walls. You may need to bring cable ties, rope and fishing wire. Please note that trestles and linen are not included in your site fee. Refer to our Stallholder Inspiration Kit for more ideas and concepts about how to best maximise your sales.

Deliveries

The Festival Village will be open for deliveries as follows:

» Fri 4 May – 12pm – 5pm

Deliveries outside of these hours are only possible by arrangement with the Festival Director. If you have a third party, such as a courier, delivering your products, please ensure they are aware of opening hours, have directions and a site map, and instruct them to contact the Festival Director.

Departure

We get that it's been a long weekend and you want to get home. But vehicles must not be driven around the site when it is open to the public. Our first priority is the safety of our patrons.

Exhibitors who fail to follow the directions of officials and/or become rude and impatient in their haste to depart will jeopardise their eligibility to return to the Festival in the future.

Escape Goats

The Escape Goats are a team of young volunteers (aged 10-15) who assist with running the Festival. They will also pick up any made up boxes you may have to use within the Winestore area for bulk purchase and allocations.

Exhibitor passes

Exhibitor passes will be provided with your exhibitor kit. You can collect your kit from the Festival Information Stand (located at the front gate) upon arrival on Friday afternoon or Saturday morning. Based on your purchase site you will be provided with

You are required to WEAR your Exhibitor Wristband **AT ALL TIMES** so GGE staff and Volunteers can identify you.

Exhibitor stands

A reminder that **NO POP UP** branded marquees are permitted. White structure marquees with names will be provided to all stalls that aren't within an activation or food truck/coffee cart.

Your marquee hire includes your stand/marquee and sign only.

- » Single site size = 3x3m
- » Double site size = 6x3m

First Aid

First Aid facilities are available within the Festival village. Please familiarise yourself with the location of the First Aid facility on the Festival site map.

Fire safety

Exhibitors using cooking equipment must have a portable fire extinguisher and fire blanket on site. If the day is declared a Total Fire Ban, exhibitors wishing to operate a barbecue or stove must have a [Permit to use a fire in the open air on a day of total fire ban](#).

- » **If you are cooking with gas** please download the brochure [Gas Safety at Public Events](#) from Energy Safe Victoria (ESV). Please complete the self-check list and take this with you to the event. Gas bottles, situated inside of a mobile food van, must be certified by the ESV. Solid fuel cooking equipment is not permitted without proper guards or barriers.

- » **Butane gas cartridge stoves** are banned from public events by Energy Safe Victoria.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Food safety

The Food Act 1984 requires that all businesses that handle, prepare, package, store, serve, supply and repackage food (including wine) must be registered with their local council. All temporary food registrations and Statements of Trade are now lodged through Streatrader.

» **If you are registered**, you must lodge a ***Statement of trade for temporary food premises*** (SOT) with the Northern Grampians Shire which also serves as notice that you intend to operate at the Grampians Grape Escape. The SOT should be lodged through your Streatrader account on <https://streatrader.health.vic.gov.au>.

Contact Streatrader on Email: streatrader@health.vic.gov.au or Tel: 1300 085 767 if you have misplaced your username and/or password.

» **If you are not registered**, you must register with your local council (approval times can vary from a few days to several weeks) and then lodge a *Statement of trade for temporary food premises* with the Northern Grampians Shire.

» Exhibitors must meet the requirements of their own **Food Safety Program** and bring a copy with them to the Festival. Food safety inspectors will be present. More details can be found on the GGE Exhibitor Portal.

Hours of operation

All exhibits must be operational while the Festival is open to the public.

- » Sat 5 May from 10am-6pm
- » Sun 6 May from 10am-4:30pm

Ice supplies

Ice can be purchased from the Festival Information Stand for \$5 per bag - Cash is payable at the time of purchase.

Insurance

Exhibitors must ensure that they have appropriate public liability insurance cover for the Festival and this has been provided to us prior to 10th April.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Liquor license

Exhibitors intending to sell alcohol must apply for a **Major Event License** from the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation. Please use the application form on the Exhibitor portal that we have partially completed for you if you want approval to serve alcohol. Appropriate service of alcohol is mandatory, and the Festival Director reserves the right to close any exhibitor's site if they do not comply with the liquor laws. **ENSURE** you have all your required regulated **LICENCE SIGNAGE** as GGE are not in position to provide if you have forgotten.

Marketing campaign

An extensive marketing campaign and rebrand of the Festival has resulted in strong ticket sales and interest to date. Mother's Day Campaign

We will be recognising any exhibitor who wishes to offer a Mother's Day Package offer such as produce hamper/ 6 bottle wine pack etc with a Pink Heart to be attached to their signage. More details will be provided in the next GGE-mail so start thinking about what you could offer or partner with neighbouring stalls.

Partner Events

GGE's Partner events and promotions take place over several weeks and are designed to promote your business and build anticipation in the lead up to the Festival, we have had a great response this year with 14 Partner Events being hosted across the region to promote our wonderful producers and experiences.

Power

Power is ordered when you submit your registration and will be supplied to one point at the rear of your site. Please bring power cords and boards to spread the power as you require. All appliances must be in good working order and tagged and tested by your own electrician prior to arrival. Power usage must be paid for at the time of registration if required.

All Exhibitor power is supplied by generators. Despite our best endeavours we cannot guarantee continuity of supply. The Festival Director reserves the right to refuse or limit power if information provided for any appliance is incorrect.

Products for sale

The mission of the Grampians Grape Escape is to showcase and celebrate the Grampians Region and its food, wine and produce artisans. Our focus is on quality rather than quantity and local rather than multi-national, mass-produced products. All products you are selling or promoting must be listed in the description provided when registering online. Fast foods and products made by multi-national companies (inc. soft drinks) are not welcome at the Festival.

If you have any products that you think may not comply with the selection criteria, please discuss them with the Festival Director.

During the Festival your site will be visited by a GGE representative to ensure the goods being sold match the information submitted when you registered.

Artwork deadline is Friday 13th of April, provided in a high res file with a 5mm bleed. GGE will provide artwork size/specs once you confirm your required size.

Poly-Carbonate Festival Tumblers

This year the festival glassware will be served in Festival GoVino Poly-carbonate stemless tumblers. The pour lines will be printed on the glassware and a sample provided to you in your Exhibitor Welcome Pack on arrival.

The Grampians Grape Escape Festival wine tumblers are available to patrons who purchase the Tasting Ticket packages only. Individual festival glasses are NOT for sale. Exhibitors will be provided with one glass per exhibitor pass, for their personal use. Any additional passes are purchased at full festival prices.

Recycling

Thanks to Grampians Central West Waste & Resource Recovery Group, 20-25 food trucks, have the opportunity to play their part in the war against waste and utilise a food scraps pick up service. This will reduce food waste going into landfill and the waste gathered will feed a bank of hungry worm farms that will then be positioned at a local primary school for observation while they produce gourmet worm castings and worm juice.

Recyclable coffee cup bins will feature at the festival as well for festival goers to utilise.

Please consider your products' packaging and limit where possible, and also consider your disposal of rubbish into the recycling bins provided. Other waste will be separated in the following streams; paper and cardboard; bottles; general waste where it cannot be utilised via the Grampians Central West Waste & Resource Recovery Group.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Safety Officer

A Safety Officer will be onsite throughout the event to ensure safe procedures are being adhered to throughout the weekend. All Exhibitors must comply with relevant Occupational Health and Safety standards and take advice from the Safety Officer as directed.

In an Emergency situation please listen for direction from the Safety Officer and Wardens.

Sales and tastings

Exhibitors are required to offer free tastings until 4pm each day.

» **Tastings are free and unlimited for Weekend Tasting ticket holders until 4pm daily for wine, beer, spirits and cider. It is up to you if you want to continue with free tastings after 4pm on Saturday or offer sales by the glass only, through until 6pm.**

» **By the glass** sales are permitted throughout the Festival weekend.

» **By the bottle/stubby** sales are permitted throughout the Festival weekend and must comply with your liquor license.

» **Take Away** please comply with your liquor Licence.

All exhibitors are required to offer free samples to Festival patrons. We encourage food trucks / vendors to provide or offer tastings in order to get sales.

Security

Security will be on site from 5pm Friday 4 May until 8am Monday 7 May. Security personnel are on-site to ensure the safety of all participants and can be approached with any concerns you may have.

Whilst every reasonable precaution will be taken, the Grampians Grape Escape Inc. accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage which may occur to persons or property at the Festival from any causes.

Site management

A Site Manager will be in attendance to coordinate and assist the Festival Director with the operational aspects of the Festival.

For those exhibitors participating in the Social Media promotion please refer to the Exhibitor Portal for your reference guide and hashtags to use. You are required to fulfil the 10 tagged posts prior to the festival. Your \$100 refund will be provided in cash on Sunday afternoon via the GGE Treasurer.

Stand signage

Stand signage is included in your registration fee. All stand signs remain the property of GGE and MUST NOT be removed. Signage is not provided for Food Trucks/Carts

Toilets

Toilets for exclusive use by Festival crew and exhibitors will be located in the Back of House area (with the sink, cool rooms etc). To access this area you must be wearing your exhibitor wristband.

Vehicles on site

We have a strict limit on the number of vehicles that can be left on site. Advance notification must be provided when you register online. All vehicles must be offsite by 9.00am Saturday and 9.00am Sunday. If you arrive late be prepared to carry your stock to your marquee from the car park. Vehicles must travel at walking pace/ 5km per hour speed limit, windows down, hazards

Vehicles must not be driven around the site when it is open to the public. Failure to meet this requirement will jeopardize your eligibility to return to the Festival in the future.

Volunteers

Each volunteer is provided with Food/Coffee Vouchers to use at any stall across the weekend as part of their Volunteer benefits. A copy of these vouchers will be provided in your Exhibitor Welcome Kit as a reference. Please accept these across the weekend and a GGE Representative will collect these from you on late Sunday afternoon. You will then be reimbursed the week following the festival for any presented vouchers to your site. They will also be picking up any donations of bottles of wine / opened bottles from tasters on late Sunday afternoon should you wish to donate for volunteer get-together held after the festival concludes.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Waste removal

Thanks to Grampians Central West Waste & Resource Recovery Group, 20-25 food trucks, have the opportunity to play their part in the war against waste and utilise a food scraps pick up service. This will reduce food waste going into landfill and the waste gathered will feed a bank of hungry worm farms that will then be positioned at a local primary school for observation while they produce gourmet worm castings and worm juice.

Dependant on demand we may be able to offer a Waste service for cooking oil used at the festival. To register your interest and how much wastage you may have please contact Kate before 15th April. Upon departure each day all Exhibitors must remove all waste from their stand prior to leaving the Festival.

Failure to meet our expectations will incur a waste removal fee and jeopardize your eligibility to return to the Festival in the future.

Water access

Water is available from the Pavilion and Back of House area. Potable water is also available from designated areas (check the site map).

Weather

The Grampians Grape Escape Festival is an all-weather event. However, if the event falls on a day that is declared to be 'code red catastrophic' fire danger, the event will be cancelled.

Wine barrels, umbrellas & flags

Exhibitors are encouraged to improve the image of their area by using umbrellas, wine barrels, flags, tables and chairs. Please consider your neighbour and ensure there is adequate space for traffic flow in and around your area and ensure they are secured to meet Safety regulations.

Wine Store

This year we have introduced the Wine Store for festival goers to be able to safely and securely leave bulk purchases at the Festival. This will operate from the Festival Information Tent and festival goers are encouraged to drop off and pick up on Sunday afternoon or Monday morning when departing Halls Gap. More details will be provided in your Exhibitor Welcome Kit on arrival and we hope it assist for some larger sales on the day knowing that your customers do not need to carry around large bulky items,

Our Festival bags have also been updated as a 6 Bottle Carry Bag with produce gusset to entice more buying across the festival. Regular Enviro Bags will also be provided to Exhibitors as extras where required.





CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Grampians Grape Escape reserves the right to reject any registration.
2. All exhibitors are required to trade from 10am - 6pm on Saturday 5 May 2018 and 10am - 4:30pm on Sunday 6 May 2018.
3. All exhibitors shall be set-up by 9:15am on Saturday 5 May 2018 and 9:30am on Sunday 6 May 2018.
4. The Exhibitor shall not, without the prior consent of the Festival Director, permit any person, group or business other than the Exhibitor, its servants and agents to occupy any part of the site.
5. The exhibitor shall not, without the prior consent of the Festival Director, extend its display over the boundaries of the site.
6. The Exhibitor will obtain knowledge of and comply with all laws, rules and regulations applicable to operating and participating in the Festival. The Exhibitor will also comply with all policies and rules of Grampians Grape Escape relating to the Festival, including the Code of Conduct, and all reasonable directions of Grampians Grape Escape representatives.
7. The Exhibitor will adhere to the Responsible Service of Alcohol at all times.
8. Grampians Grape Escape will not be liable for loss, or damage to the Exhibitor's property while on the site.
9. The Exhibitor should hold public liability insurance cover of at least \$10 million indemnifying members of the public against accident while on the Exhibitor's site. This cover should also indemnify the public against injury occasioned by the Exhibitor's equipment and machinery.
10. Only the Festival public address systems may be used, unless express approval has been given by the Festival Director.
11. All sites should be vacated by 6pm Sunday 6 May 2018 and left in a clean and reasonable condition prior to departure. Exhibitors must remove all waste from their stand prior to leaving the Festival or a fee may be charged.
12. If Grampians Grape Escape should find it necessary or expedient to cancel or postpone the Festival it shall not be liable for any compensation or refund to exhibitors, whether on the ground of loss of profits or otherwise or any refund of payment of any money paid by the Exhibitor in relation to this contract in respect of such cancellation or suspension.
13. Grampians Grape Escape reserves the right to cancel an Exhibitor's registration and retain any money paid in relation thereto if there is, in the opinion of the Festival Director, an infringement of any of the conditions and/ or if the Exhibitor does not occupy the space at the commencement of and during the full period of the Festival. Such sites may be reallocated.
14. Except with the written consent previously obtained from the Festival Director the Exhibitor shall not assign or sub-let or part with the possession of the whole or any part of the space or purport to do so.
15. Exhibitors must, before digging any holes or driving any objects into the ground, ensure that there are no underground power cables, telephone cables or water pipes which could be damaged or cause injury to the Exhibitor or his staff. All damages caused by Exhibitors or their staff will be repaired at Exhibitor's expense.
16. Refunds are not payable if you simply change your mind, however if your circumstances change you must contact us in writing. A cancellation fee of 50% will apply if you contact us no later than 60 days prior to commencement of the Festival. Should you cancel less than 60 days prior to the commencement of the Festival, no refund will be payable. Refunds will be paid within 90 days of the conclusion of the Festival.
17. All food distributed to patrons (either sold or given away) on site, must comply with Health Regulations. Where food is being prepared a suitable fire extinguisher must be present on the site.
18. Grampians Grape Escape reserves the right to amend operating conditions as specified at any time and regulate the use of equipment by exhibitors which in their opinion produces excessive noise.
19. Exhibitors shall conform with the requirements of any Act of Parliament which may govern the erection of structures, the display and/or other products or goods of the exhibitors and the regulation by-laws and ordinances made under such Act.
20. While Grampians Grape Escape provides power to sites and every endeavour is made to provide continuity of supply, the Exhibitor acknowledges that Grampians Grape Escape cannot, and does not, guarantee continuity of supply of any service (including power) and shall not be liable for any 'outage' or disruption to the supply of any service or the consequence of such outage.

CODE OF CONDUCT


1. Be courteous during all dealings with patrons, staff and volunteers.
2. No abusive or foul language will be tolerated.
3. Follow the direction of staff and volunteers, particularly in relation to parking and movement of vehicles.
4. Provide payment for all services and items requested and used prior to entering the Festival Village or using the service or item.
5. Provide correct information and refrain from deceptive conduct.

SANCTIONS

Where an Exhibitor fails to comply with the event conditions and rules Grampians Grape Escape may impose one or more of the following:

1. Removal from the Festival Village during the Festival.
2. Require immediate payment of any fees owing.
