The Grampians Winemakers Barrique Auction is back at Grampians Grape Escape on Saturday, May 4th, featuring the 31st vintage of the Barrique, the '2022 Grampians Winemakers Reserve Shiraz.'

Back vintages will also be available, offering a unique opportunity to acquire these rare wines. Started in 1991 to help put the Grampians wine region on the map, the auction has become a tradition eagerly anticipated by wine enthusiasts. This year's auction will support the recovery efforts for Pomonal and the region, with a portion of the funds dedicated to staging a hero event at Pomonal Estate as part of the Grampians Fine Wine Festival in October.

The 2022 vintage was blended by Chief Winemaker Adam Louder of Mount Langi Ghiran, who is celebrating 40 vintages at 43 years of age. Don't miss this rare chance to take home a taste of the Grampians. Taste and register at the Barrique Bar before 2pm and then head to the auction at 2:15pm.





Renowned for their entertaining and energetic live cover shows, this brass-driven party band is set to ignite the stage and take us out for 2024.






St Arnaud
